The RCR network

The Regional Cycle Routes (Itinéraires Cyclables Régionaux/Gewestelijke Fietsroutes) consist of 10 to 15 km marked cycle routes, often crossing multiple Brussels municipalities. They follow local routes on which there is less traffic, which makes them less stressful to navigate.

The 19 RCRs constitute a coherent network of cycle routes:

- **transversal** (they cover the entire Brussels-Capital region);
- **radial** (from the outskirts towards the centre);
- **different loops** throughout the Region.



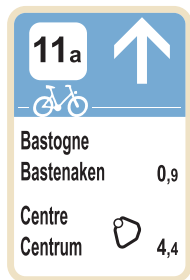
Example of the RCR network

The RCR-network is indicated by signposts and road markings.

There exist two kinds of **sign posts**:

- signposts indicating the route's direction, the number of kilometres for intermediary and final destinations.

It also mentions the Brussels train and public transport stations;



- signposts indicating the spots where different tracks cross each other.



The road markings consist of a double chevron accompanied by a bike logo. The chevrons bear off right before a crossing to notify cyclists of a turn. They reappear after each crossing in order to confirm that the cyclist is on the right track.
